Since the inception of the Human Trafficking Taskforce of Butler County in 2022 until today, data shows that the exploitation of children continues to remain on the rise.



**Child Sexual Abuse Material (CSAM)**  
Child sexual abuse material has **increased** by **14%**.



**Human Trafficking: Sex**  
Human sex trafficking involving children has **increased** by **50%**.

### Get Educated

Per research, statistics, and most importantly- from the experiences of survivors of human trafficking- it is not white vans, expensive furniture, or zip ties that generate human trafficking. In actuality, many survivors have been trafficked by perceived romantic partners, family members, and even parents.

### Get the Conversation Started

Ask the kids & young adults in your life questions (even the uncomfortable ones). Know about what's happening in their lives, both on and offline. Get & stay connected (they really do appreciate it!)
